A welcome return of the Linden Wind Orchestra to the Vera Fletcher Hall as part of our Sunday night concert series.

The Linden Wind Orchestra was founded in 1984 by Roger Phillips, and very quickly became established as one of South East England's foremost wind ensembles. They will be playing Gershwin's An American in Paris, Dvorak's New World Symphony (Finale) and John William's Star Wars.

The LWO has performed extensively locally at grand dinner functions and outdoor 'Proms in the Park' concerts, and has taken part in many high-profile fund-raising events. In May 2011 they were featured as part BBC Radio 3's Light Fantastic Music Festival. The Linden Wind Orchestra produced its first commercial recording (White Sands) in 2005 on the occasion of its 20th anniversary.

The LWO will be under the direction of guest conductor **Matthew Scott Rogers**
